I am directed to state that, the Municipal General Elections to 5 (five) Urban Local Bodies and Bye-Elections to 29 (twenty nine) Municipal Constituencies (Ward) as per enclosed list are scheduled to be held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2013.

The Government Expects that all Employers of Mercantile firms, Shops & Commercial Establishments and industrial Undertakings/Establishments located in the concerned Municipalities will take actions so that full facilities are extended to all categories of workmen and employees who may be voters in respect of the said Municipalities for exercising their right of franchise.

The government will appreciate, if your organisation advises your constituent members in whose unit Friday is a working day, to grant an additional paid holiday on the day of poll (viz. 22.11.2013) to the concerned constituency to all categories of workers and employees to enable them to exercise their right to franchise in the said Municipal General Elections / Bye Elections.

There may be some electors ordinarily residing in the area under any one of the concerned Municipalities but having their place of work in another area. In such cases, such voters should be given a special leave or maximum facilities to exercise their right to franchise.
