**ORDER**

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 140 of The West Bengal Panchayat (Amendment) Act, 2012 and Section 140 of The West Bengal Panchayat (Second Amendment) Act, 2012 read with Sections 16 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections Act, 2003 and Section 17 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections ( Amendment ) Act, 2012 and Section 17 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections ( Second Amendment ) Act, 2012 read with Rules 26 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections Rules, 2006 ( as Amended vide No 5013/PN/O/3R-1/2012 dated 24-09-2012 of P&RD Deptt., Govt. of West Bengal ) and Rule 27 of the West Bengal Panchayat Elections Rules, 2006, West Bengal State Election Commission, hereby publish the draft Order for delimitation of **Purba Medinipur Zilla Parishad** constituencies and reservation of seats thereto for Panchayat General Elections 2018. The Block(s) have been specified in column (1) of the Schedule below (hereinafter referred to as the said Schedule), the number of members to be elected to the Zilla Parishad specified in the corresponding entries in column (2), to divide the area of the Block into constituencies specified in the corresponding entries in column (3), to determine the constituency or constituencies reserved for the Scheduled Tribes(ST), Scheduled Castes (SC) or the Backward Classes (BC) specified in the corresponding entries in column (4) and the constituency or constituencies reserved for women specified in the corresponding entries in column (5) of the said schedule.

The draft will be taken up for consideration by the State Election Commissioner after fifteen days from this day.

Any objection or suggestion with respect thereto received by the Commission within the said period, shall be duly considered.
