ORDER

WHEREAS section 87 of the West Bengal Municipal Elections Act, 1994 (West Ben. Act XXXIV of 1994) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act) provides, inter alia, that provisions for requisitioning premises and vehicles and payment of compensation therefore shall be such as are provided in the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951).

AND WHEREAS such provisions are provided in sections 160 and 161 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951).

AND WHEREAS in the absence of specific mention of sections 160 and 161 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) in section 87 of the said Act, difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of section 87 of the said Act.

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provision of section 91 of the said Act, the Governor, in consultation with the West Bengal State Election Commission, is pleased hereby to direct that the provisions of sections 160 and 161 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) shall be followed for the purposes of requisitioning of premises and vehicles and payment of compensation there for in connection with the elections to the Municipalities in West Bengal.
